

# STEM AMBASSADOR VOLUNTEER ROLE DESCRIPTION

STEM Ambassadors take part in a wide range of STEM-related activities that promote science, technology, engineering and maths as subject choices and career opportunities to young people aged 3-18. All volunteers must be aged 17 or over.

## LOCATION

The activities that STEM Ambassadors can volunteer for take place in schools and youth groups across the country, either in person or remotely. STEM Learning cannot reimburse travel costs so volunteers should stay local to them for in-person activities, with the option to help with any further afield using technology.

## TIME COMMITMENT

Volunteers are required to complete, and record on their online profile, a minimum of one activity in every rolling 12-month period. This can be an activity you volunteer for using the STEM Ambassadors website, or one you organise yourself. We hope you'll take part in much more than one per year!

## SKILLS, ATTITUDES & EXPERIENCE NEEDED

The role will suit people who are enthusiastic about their subject area, and enjoy engaging with a range of young people both in-person and remotely. STEM Ambassadors should conduct themselves in a professional manner and be respectful to everyone they engage with.
